IMMIGRATION JUSTICE/ SANCTUARY

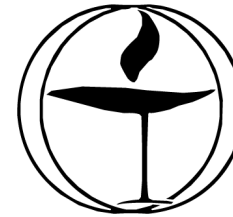
This group works on our churchwide social justice project involving immigration and sanctuary. Activities include book and film discussions, cottage meetings and more.
