	Items for auction bidding are donated by UUCMP Members and Friends. Categories are Food, Get-Together, Goods, and Services. This is a great chance to apply your experience and imagination to benefit our church community. Please see the "Donors" section below.			
	The auction catalog will be online at the church's <i>FABULOUS FICTION</i> auction web site, hosted by Auctria: https://auctria.events/UUCMP2024. All Silent Auction bidding will be conducted online via Auctria; Live Auction bidding will be both in-person in the church sanctuary, and online via Zoom. Anyone who registers as a Bidder may bid on items in the Service Auction.			
	Donors and Bidders are encouraged to register online through the Auctria site, where Donors can post their own Item(s) for the catalog. <i>Anyone who has an Auctria login from a previous year does not need register again</i> , but please confirm contact information is current (especially the email address). Bidders may directly register at the web site, https://auctria.events/UUCMP2024, by clicking **Bidders** on the Register link. You will need to provide a valid email address for both your login ID and to receive auction information (e.g., bid status, statements). You will need to create a password for subsequent secure logins to your account. For participating without a computer, please submit a Bidder Registration Form, on the last page of this document (with instructions). During online bidding, your identity will be kept confidential – only you will know the status of your own bids. Bids may be submitted either through your login at the Auctria web site, or by using the Auctria app on an Android or iOS (Apple) device (search for "Auctria" in your respective app store to download the free app). Auctria allows, but does not require, your registration of a credit card within the system. With a registered credit card, you will be able to immediately pay for winning-bid Items by clicking the Checkout button at the bottom of your emailed statement. Certain Items have been selected for bidding during the Live Auction in the UUCMP sanctuary Live Auction on October 26. These are included in the Catalog, but are not available for Silent Auction bidding. Zoom attendees will be able to place bids through Zoom chat, monitored by in-person proxy bidders at the church. In addition to the bidding, we will have literature-themed games for group participation. Start thinking about your favorite fictional character; a costume (optional!) makes it more fun. Light refreshments will be provided, but feel free to bring your own. Children will be entertained under adult supervision, separate from the sanctuary. **Payment** Auctria allows Bidders to register credit cards within the system to directly pay for their winning bids through their emailed Bidder statement, by clicking the "Checkout" button. UUCMP allows other forms of payment, as well: cash (in a sealed envelope, delivered to the church office), personal check, bank direct payment (bank-issued check), PayPal, or a credit card you registered in the Breeze data system. See the church website, uucmp.org, Donate link, to use PayPal. For any payment method outside of the Auctria system, please include a memo or note with "Auction 2024, Item # nnn" citing the Catalog number(s) of the Item(s) covered by the payment. 

199 ** HOW TO BID ON MORE THAN ONE "SEAT" in a group Item **

Get-Together items, and some Service items, offer multiple "seats" or slots for the occasion. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO BID ON MORE THAN ONE SEAT OR SLOT for a particular item (for example, for two places at the dinner table), then please follow this procedure.



After you place a bid for one seat, when you click "Bid" again it gives you the choice of updating your existing bid (for example, to increase the amount of the bid) or to bid for an additional item. Click in the little "Please select" box, and choose "Place a new bid". You can do this for as many of the offered seats as are available.

ONE SEAT (slot) MEANS ONE PERSON - if you have a family or group desiring to attend, you need to bid on one seat for each person.

Note that a higher bid which arrives later from someone else may displace one of the bids you made, but not the other(s) – the multiple bids you place are not identified within the system as being linked together. In the two-for-dinner example, you will need to increase your bid on both seats to surpass a bid from someone else that "bumped" one of yours.
