Overview	As UUCMP has successfully done for the past four years, we are once again using a web-based auction service to manage this year's event, <i>BEING GREEN</i> . Auction proceeds will support UUCMP's operations during the church year.				
	Items for auction bidding are donated by UUCMP Members and Friends. Categories are Food, Get-Together, Goods, and Services. This is a great chance to apply your experience and imagination to benefit our church community. Please see the "Donors" section below.				
	The auction catalog will be online at the church's <i>BEING GREEN</i> auction web site, hosted by Auctria: https://auctria.events/UUCMP2025. All Silent Auction bidding will be conducted online via Auctria; Live Auction bidding will be both in-person in the church sanctuary, and online via Zoom. Anyone who registers as a Bidder may bid on items in the Service Auction.				
	Donors and Bidders are encouraged to register online through the Auctria site, where Donors can post their own Item(s) for the catalog. <i>Anyone who has an Auctria login from a previous year does not need register again</i> , but please confirm that your contact information is current (especially the email address). 	Please provide a reasonable market value for your item. This determines the starting point for bidding, and will help both you and the winning bidder to determine income tax deductibility.

Bidders	Bidders may directly register at the web site, https://auctria.events/UUCMP2025, by clicking on the <i>Register</i> link. You will need to provide a valid email address for both your login ID and to receive auction information (e.g., bid status, statements). You will need to create a password for subsequent secure logins to your account.		
	During online bidding, your identity will be kept confidential – only you will know the status of your own bids. Bids may be submitted either through your login at the Auctria web site, or by using the Auctria app on an Android or iOS (Apple) device (search for "Auctria" in your respective app store to download the free app).		
	Auctria allows, but does not require, your registration of a credit card within the system. With a registered credit card, you will be able to immediately pay for winning-bid Items by clicking the <i>Checkout</i> button at the bottom of your emailed statement. (You must click <i>Checkout</i> – Auctria will not process a charge against your credit card without your specific authorization.) 	If you will be unavailable to participate during the auction period, but would nevertheless like to bid on Items in the Catalog, we can set up Proxy bidding instructions. Live Auction	Certain Items will be selected for bidding during the Live Auction on October 25. These are included in the Catalog, but are not available for Silent Auction bidding. Zoom attendees will be able to place bids through Zoom chat, monitored by in-person proxy bidders at the church.		
	In addition to the bidding, we will have "green"-themed games for group participation. Think about how you would like to be "seen as green"; a costume (optional!) makes it more fun.		
	Refreshments will be provided, but anything edible you care to contribute to the occasion would be most welcome. Child care will be provided for the evening, and children are welcome to dress in a costume for the occasion (a dress rehearsal for Halloween, perhaps?)		
Payment	Auctria allows Bidders to register credit cards within the system to directly pay for their winning bids through their emailed Bidder statement, by clicking the "Checkout" button. UUCMP allows other forms of payment, as well: cash (in a sealed envelope, delivered to the church office), personal check, bank direct payment (bank-issued check), PayPal, or a credit card you registere in the Breeze data system. 	For any payment method outside of the Auctria system, please include a memo or note saying "Auction 2025".

** HOW TO BID ON MORE THAN ONE "SEAT" in a group Item **

Get-Together items, and some Service items, offer multiple "seats" or slots for the occasion. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO BID ON MORE THAN ONE SEAT OR SLOT for a particular item (for example, for two places at the dinner table), then please follow this procedure.

After you place a bid for one seat, you have the choice of updating your existing bid (for example, to increase the amount of the bid *) or to bid for an additional item. To bid for an additional seat, click the dark-grey "Place New Bid" box, enter the additional bid amount, and click the blue "Bid [amount]" box. You can do this for as many of the offered seats as are available.

ONE SEAT (slot) MEANS ONE PERSON - if you have a family or group desiring to attend, you need to bid on one seat for each person.

Note that a higher bid which arrives later from someone else may displace one of the bids you made, but not the other(s) – the multiple bids you place are not identified within the system as being linked together. In the two-for-dinner example, you will need to increase your bid on both seats to surpass a bid from someone else that "bumped" one of yours.

* Click the "Replace Bid" box when you want to change the amount of a bid you placed earlier, for example, if someone has outbid you. If you have multiple bids of different amounts already registered, the system will ask you with a drop-down list, which of your bids you want to replace.
